

Mobile Phone Policy

PHILOSOPHICAL BASIS

School mobile phones are modern day communication tools, and when effectively managed are useful in providing a safer school environment.

GUIDELINES

- Students are not to bring personal mobile phones to school and/or school activities unless permission from the principal has been sought by parents and the mobile phone is deemed necessary.
- Mobile phones must remain switched off during school hours. 8.45 – 3.30
- Students mobile phones must not be used while on school property
- Parents who wish to contact students will be able to do so via the school office during school hours.
- Parents who wish to contact students in Out of Hours School Care will be able to do so via the OHSC contact number.
- Students who bring a mobile phone to school without prior approval and/or misuse their mobile phone will have it stored at the office until collected by a parent/guardian.
- The school does not accept responsibility for lost or damaged student mobile phones.
- The principal may revoke a student's permission to bring a mobile phone to school.
- On excursions and camps parents who wish to contact children may do so via the school.
- Phones brought to school must be stored at the office and signed in and out.
